- **Guest Speaker** – Lori Greenwell, FBI Special Agent was the guest speaker. SA Lori Greenwell has been employed with the FBI for 22 years after serving in the US Army for 7 years. She has served in Washington, DC; Albuquerque, NM; Anchorage, AK; and transferred to Louisville last year. She has worked various investigations within the FBI to include: Violent Crimes - kidnappings, carjackings, bank robberies, servitude/slavery, human trafficking, Indian Country which includes homicides, rapes and child molestations; White Collar Crime which includes investment and mortgage fraud, health care fraud, and public corruption. She has worked 3 major public corruption undercover investigations which resulted in the arrests of numerous state legislators, state auditor and treasurers, state senators, police officers and a US Senator. She has experience with Foreign Counterintelligence cases involving economic espionage and "spies." Currently SA Greenwell is the Joint Terrorism Task Force Coordinator for the Louisville FBI, as well as the Special Events Coordinator for major events within the region which require national security coordination such as the KY Derby.

In addition to the above casework and duties, SA Greenwell has been a Crisis Negotiation Coordinator for 17 years and is currently the Louisville Crisis Negotiation Coordinator (team leader). She has utilized negotiations in over 267 crisis incidents which include hostage situations involving bank robbers, domestic situations, kidnappings and international kidnapping; as well as assisted other agencies in over 60 incidents over the telephone. She provides training to numerous local and state agencies which recently included a 5 day basic course in Paducah, KY and training to the KY Corrections Department.

Special Agent Greenwell shared a wealth of information regarding FBI cases across the country and how local businesses can help. The FBI's national security mission is to lead and coordinate intelligence efforts that drive actions to protect the United States. Their goal is to develop a comprehensive understanding of the threats and penetrate national and transnational networks that have a desire and capability to harm us. Such networks include: terrorist organizations, foreign intelligence services, those that seek to proliferate weapons of mass destruction, and criminal enterprises.
