Property Valuation Reassessments

You may notice an increase in your property assessment this year. Jefferson County is broken into nine market areas. Each area is inspected on a quadrennial schedule per Kentucky State Law. Lyndon has 2 areas, #8 and 9, depending on which side of LaGrange Rd. you live.

When the assessment of your property increases or decreases from the prior year, the Jefferson County Property Valuation Administrator (PVA) will send you a reassessment notice in late April. However, you do not have to receive a reassessment notice to contest your property assessment. As a property owner, you have the right to contest your assessment each year. By law, certain steps must be followed in the process. The PVA granted an extended period for this process, from Noon April 22nd-4pm May 16th, 2022 for Jefferson County property owners to complete the first step of the appeals process: The Online Conference.

During that time, if you believe your assessment does not represent the fair market value of your property, you can request a review from the Jefferson County PVA by participating in the Online Conference process. Louisville Metro District Changes

In December, Metro Louisville finalized new boundaries of the Metro Council Districts. Every ten years the Census data requires the districts to be reevaluated. The 2022 Census showed Jefferson County’s population increased by 41,000 from 2010. If you are affected by this redistricting, it will change who you contact at Metro Council and what candidates you will vote for in the 2022 general election this November. Lyndon currently has District 7, 17 and 18. You can see the entire district map on the Louisville Metro website (www.louisvilleky.gov) and search by your address. Food Pantry


