

Ormsby Lane Improvements Project

The 900 block of Ormsby Lane and the intersection of Old Whippys Mill Road will be closing soon for our over-due improvement project. MSD has finally given approval to our contractor to widen 800ft of roadway, install a berm between the pond and the road, and install a sidewalk along the fence line of the Lyndon Lakes community. This is the first phase of the project to improve the entire length of Ormsby Lane off New LaGrange Road. Once completed, the road will be a standard width of 22ft and connect all the sidewalks currently in place. Signage will soon be in place alerting drivers of imminent closure and detours.

Leaf Removal

Fall is here! The Lyndon City office is preparing your annual leaf removal letters with your scheduled pick-up dates. These should be in mailboxes by mid to late October. The City provides two service dates per resident. The two services have proven to be effective for everyone regardless of where your street falls on the list. Your city taxes pay for this valuable service and we ask that you take advantage of both dates. PLEASE READ your letter for rules for a successful removal.

Arbor Day Observance

Sunday, October 6th, Lyndon will celebrate Arbor Day and our 24th year being recognized as "Tree City USA". 100 Maple trees are available to Lyndon residents at the Fall Festival. Autumn is the perfect time to plant a tree!

Housekeeping Reminders

- Clear blocked catch basins, especially during fall leaf season to prevent flooding.
- Remove temporary signs for yard sales or lost pets promptly. These signs clutter the environment and are illegal.
- Car break-ins continue to be a problem in the entire Louisville area. We want to remind everyone to secure their vehicles and remove any visible personal belongings when leaving cars unattended. To keep your valuables safe, remember to:
 - Do not leave a garage door opener in a car.
 - Never leave a firearm in a vehicle.
 - Lock your doors and roll up the windows – Thieves often target unlocked cars, especially in bad weather when fewer people are outside to notice suspicious activity.



Rental Property Registration
Louisville Metro Department of Codes & Regulations requires registration of all rental units. Fees range from \$25 to \$250, with fines up to \$100 per day per unregistered unit.
